If the explanation contradicts the correct answer, the assessor may mark the entire question incorrect and give 0 points, depending on the severity of the mismatch.

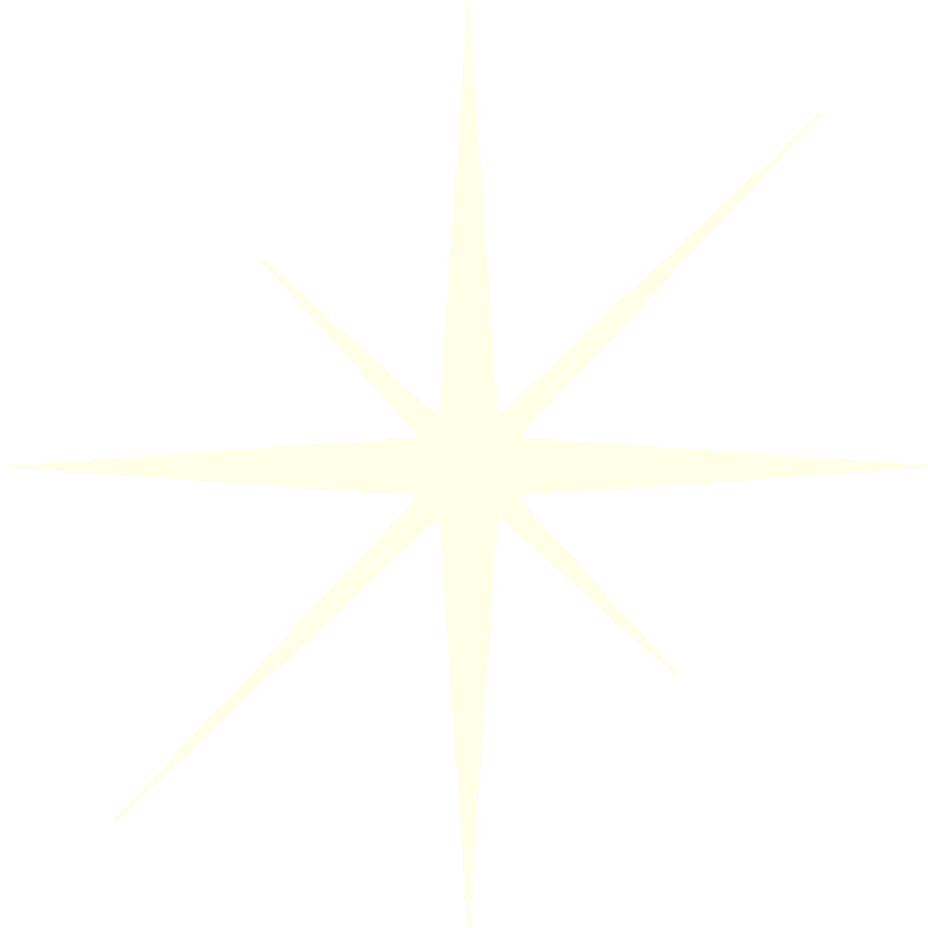

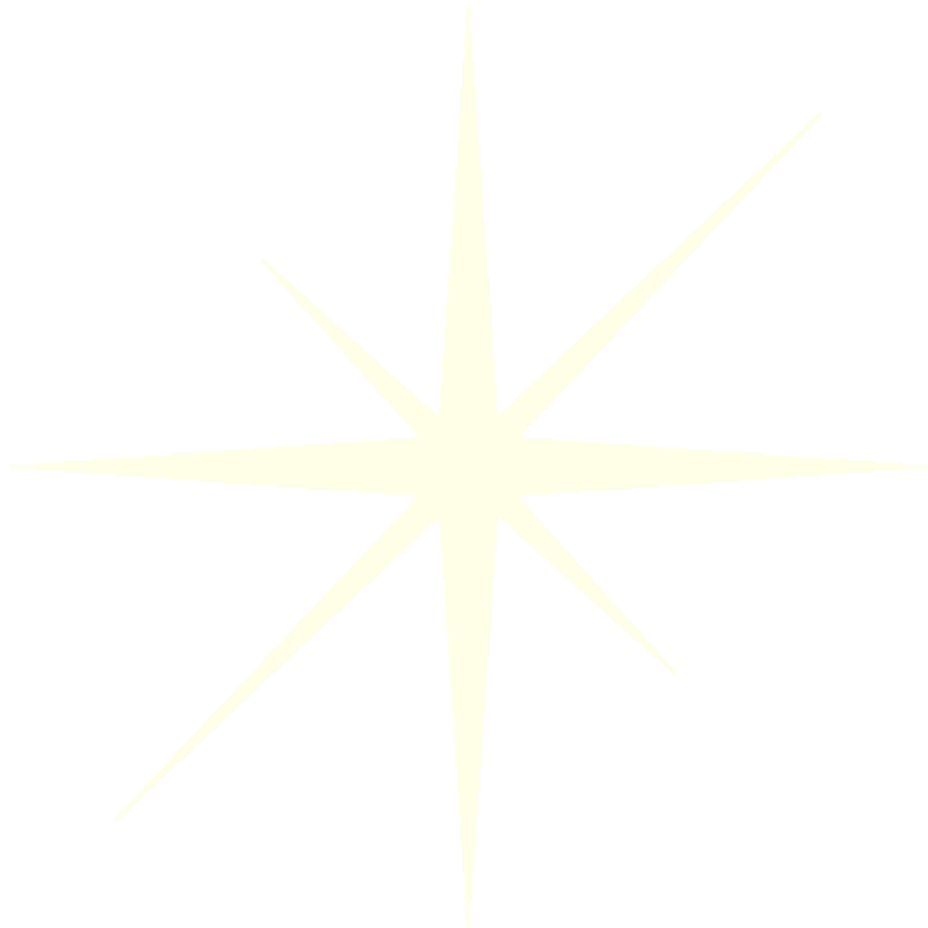
